Facilitated groups of peers who share knowledge to enhance thought leadership and education program quality.

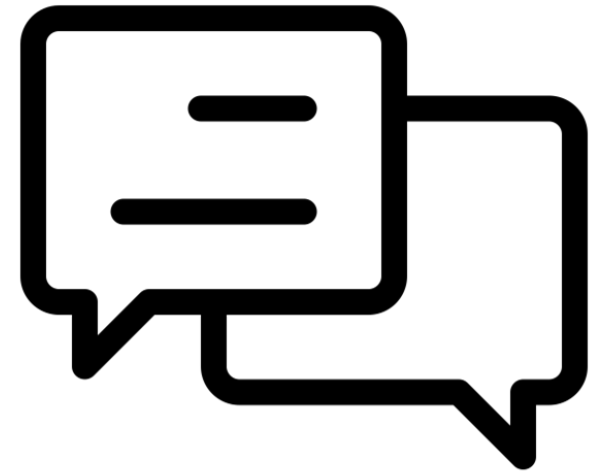
- Open, rolling enrollment

- Global Platform includes Higher Education Learning Network, Education in Crisis and Conflict Network, and Regional Hubs

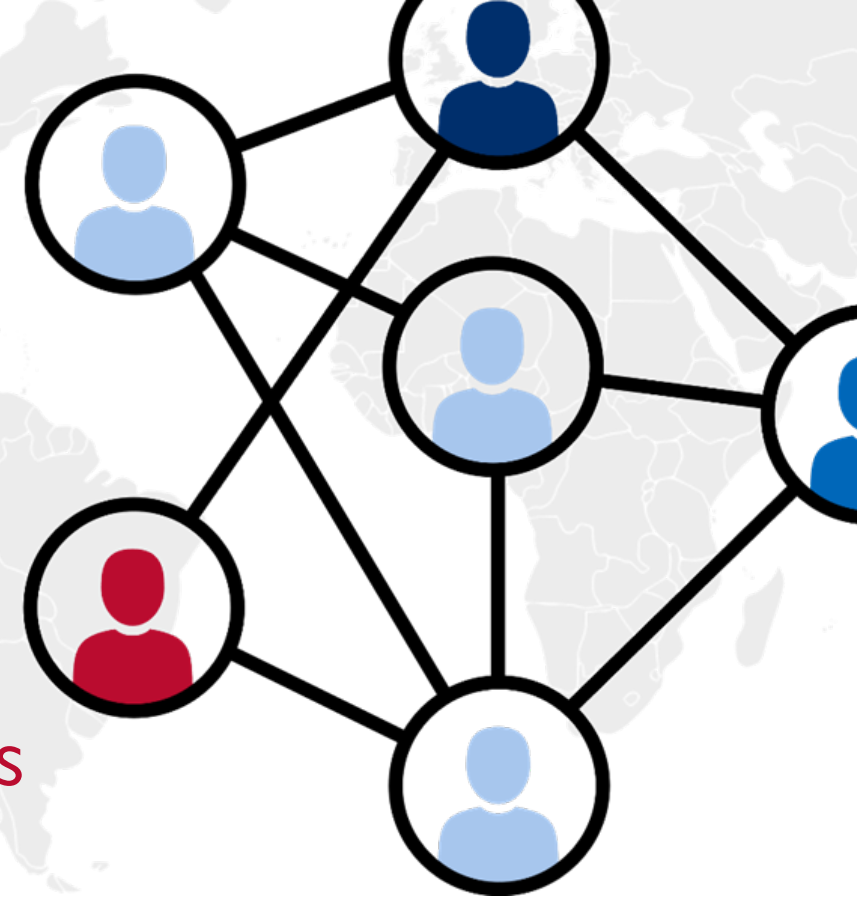

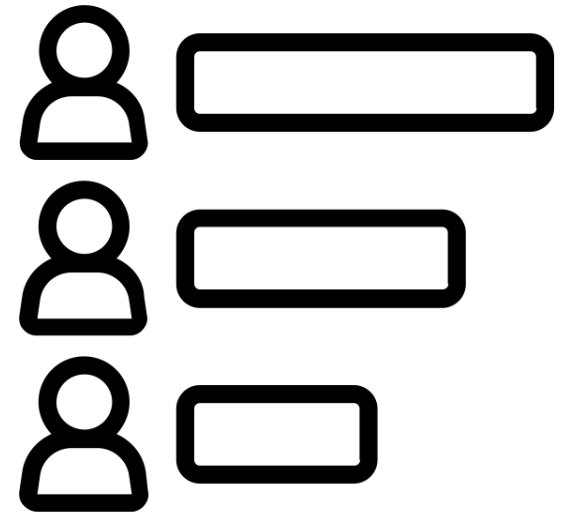
